Laurel Health is on a mission to improve healthcare access for patients of all ages in rural northcentral PA. Too many people living in rural areas must delay care due to access and costs. Laurel Health has worked diligently to expand access to health and dental services throughout Tioga, Bradford, and Sullivan Counties.

One of the reasons Laurel Health has continued to thrive for over 50 years is our dedication to adapting to meet our community's evolving health needs. From new services and ways to connect with our patients to growing our clinics and staff, we guide our strategic vision by keeping patients' needs as our guiding principle and cornerstone.

Dental access has remained a pressing concern in our communities. Over the past year, we worked together to grow our mobile dental program, expert team, and locations, now serving patients in **Blossburg**, **Laporte**, **Lawrenceville**, **Towanda**, and **Troy**. In the summer of 2024, we incorporated the former Bradford County Dental office into our health system to become **Laurel Dental Towanda at Progress Plaza**, and this spring, we began providing dental services in Sullivan County for the first time. We also proudly launched the **Towanda Laurel Health Center** in downtown Towanda, PA, and the **Sullivan County Laurel Health Center** in Laporte, PA.

To help us celebrate delivering care to more patients, this publication highlights the hard work of everyone working tirelessly to bring much-needed support to local families, who can now utilize our sliding fee program to assure access to the services they need. On behalf of our board and leadership team, **thank you for trusting us with your care**. Together, we're finding new ways to provide needed services, celebrate wins, and champion teamwork in our mission to ensure *every* family receives the quality healthcare they deserve.

Measuring Our Community Impact



Continuing to Grow to Better Meet Your Needs

Laurel Health is on a mission to improve access to **holistic healthcare** by growing our team of experts, services, and locations to better meet community needs across rural northcentral PA. Our efforts have seen us debut brand-new clinics, expand into more counties, and launch fresh, innovative programs to bring more services into community spaces through our school-based mental health support and mobile dental services.

Our team is seeing more patients than ever before with a service area of **seven counties** across northern Pennsylvania and southern New York:

- Bradford County, PA
- Chemung County, NY
- Lycoming County, PA
- Potter County, PA
- Steuben County, NY
- Sullivan County, PA
- Tioga County, PA



In 2024, **Laurel Health** treated a total of 25,617 unique patients across the health system; the graph (*above right*) demonstrates how many individual patients we saw per year over the last seven years. Please note this figure does not reflect the total number of patient visits to our locations, as it does not factor in multiple visits per patient. Through our services, sponsorships, wages, and taxes, we contributed nearly **18 million dollars** to our communities last year.

More Locations, More Patients Served

Expanding Health & Dental Services in Towanda and Laporte



This year, Laurel Health achieved major expansions in our Bradford County-based dental and family medicine care. We acquired Bradford County Dental's office space as the former dentist retired to debut a second Towanda dental practice: Laurel Dental Towanda at Progress Plaza. Our public health hygienists provide routine cleanings and basic dental care care weekdays in Suite #6 of the Progress Plaza building at 1 Elizabeth St. (pictured left). To make an appointment, call 570-265-2069.

After months of hard work, we also commemorated the grand opening of our brand-new **Towanda Laurel Health Center** in August at 410 Main St., Suites 101 to 104, in Towanda, PA. As part of our National Health Center Week celebration, we held a special ribbon cutting with legislative representatives, executive leadership, local community leaders, providers, and staff followed by public open houses during local community events like Hometown Christmas.

The Towanda LHC offers comprehensive chronic condition management, <u>family medicine</u>, <u>mental health</u>, acute care, and <u>women's health</u> services Monday to Friday from 8 am - 5 pm. New patients of all ages are being accepted at **570-266-5882**.









Improving Access to Care in Northcentral PA

Laurel Health Expands Care into Sullivan County with Laporte Clinic



Access to affordable dental and family medicine care remains challenging in many rural areas. The **Laurel Health Centers** are on a mission to change that. Over the past four years, we have diligently expanded services in Tioga and Bradford Counties to help meet local need.

Earlier this year, **Laurel Health** was approached for help with sustaining healthcare in Laporte, PA. In April, **Laurel Health** extended health and dental services into Sullivan County after

acquiring the former medical and dental clinics located at 217 King St. in Laporte, PA. As part of the transition, the two clinics integrated to become one unified health and dental center called the Sullivan County Laurel Health Center.

"Laurel Health stepped in to continue providing both expert dental and primary care services with this talented existing team as well as recruiting additional providers to support the center," shared **James A. Nobles, Laurel Health's CEO**. "Our team acted quickly in collaboration with community leaders to avoid an extended disruption in local healthcare and to stop the loss of a key safety-net health resource."

Laurel Health services offered in Sullivan County include family medicine, acute care, chronic condition management, walk-in care, dental services, and routine wellness care with plans to add mental and behavioral health services in the future. Laurel Health Mobile Dental Program a Resounding Success



Our **mobile dental program** brings dental exams and routine cleanings directly to patients who can't easily travel to a dental office, and it has been eagerly welcomed into the community.

After piloting the mobile setup at the **Wellsboro Laurel Health Center**, we expanded our mobile services to treat pediatric patients onsite at early learning centers and daycare programs throughout Tioga and Bradford Counties.

Laurel Health's mobile dental program provides routine cleanings, fluoride treatments, dental evaluations, and basic imaging. If a problem is identified or more involved dental repair work is needed, the mobile team can schedule patients for follow-up care with a dentist at one of the six **Laurel Dental** clinics in Bradford, Tioga, and Sullivan Counties. Our team gave free tetanus shots to aid storm relief in Cowanesque valley, created a career closet to help staff curate business wear and scrubs more affordably, served PA's health advisory board, provided dental education to local daycares, and celebrated new clinics in Bradford and Sullivan Counties: Laurel Dental Towanda at Progress Plaza, Towanda Laurel Health Center, and Sullivan County Laurel Health Center.
